## 1. PARISH RECYCLING SCHEME

Residual waste refers to the material that remains after separation has taken place. In a domestic sense, this can refer to the household rubbish that could (but is still not) being recycled, re-used or composted.

### Some interesting facts from [www.recycling-guide.org.uk](http://www.recycling-guide.org.uk):

- Up to 60% of the rubbish that ends up in the dustbin could be recycled.
- Unreleased energy contained in the average dustbin each year could power a television for 5,000 hours.
- The largest lake in the Britain could be filled with rubbish from the UK in 8 months.
- On average, 16% of the money spent on a product pays for packaging, which ultimately ends up as rubbish.
